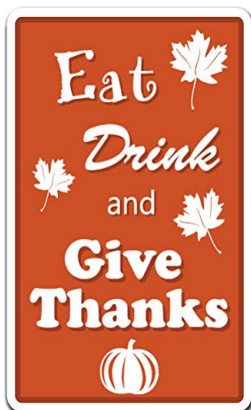


Veterans Day
